Talk at Aģenzija Sapport

Caritas Malta Epilepsy Association led a training for eleven Agenzija Sapport workers in Swatar on Friday, 8th February. The one and a half hour training was led by Professor Janet Mifsud and included a time for questions and answers, a power point presentation that covers basic information about epilepsy, the different types, and how to help when needed. There were also video clips of actual seizures of various types to help workers better understand. Robin Pinkston shared her experience as the mother of a son with epilepsy and Noel Mercieca shared from his previous experiences as a nurse. All eleven of the participants indicated on their evaluation forms that the session was "Good" or "Excellent" and all of them increased in their knowledge and confidence about what to do if they had a client have a seizure. We thank them for their obvious interest and support and for the work they do to help people with disabilities and their families! Education is power! CMEA held a training session for Agenzija Sapport workers today involving a presentation, video clips and discussions covering basic information about epilepsy. Presentation to CRPD

Caritas Malta Epilepsy Association (CMEA) has launched a toolkit in English and Maltese in conjunction with International Epilepsy Day on 11 February 2019, which is celebrated worldwide on the second Monday in February. The toolkit was funded by PEKTUR, a funding scheme by the Commissioner for the Promotion of the Rights for Persons with Disability. Mr Frank Portelli, President of CMEA presented a copy of the toolkit to Mr Oliver Scicluna, Commissioner CPRD.

In his presentation, Mr Portelli explained how epilepsy is the most common neurological brain disorder, caused by abnormal excessive electric discharges. It affects over 1% of population worldwide and around 4000 persons in Malta and Gozo. Many advances have been made on its causes and several new medicines are now available which control seizures in over 70% of cases. Yet, in several countries, including Europe, persons with epilepsy still face social exclusion and discrimination. This adversely affects employment and education of persons with this condition. Over the last two decades, CMEA, which was set up by voluntary workers in 1996, and now lists almost 300 members, has been working hard to promote more local awareness about epilepsy. This toolkit is intended to provide basic information on the condition to the public and it also provides information which will help persons with epilepsy be better equipped to have a better quality of life. It is intended to complement the medical advice and instructions given by the medical professionals.

The toolkit will be used by CMEA to supplement their outreach activities and training programmes to various stakeholders.



Mr Frank Portelli, President of the Caritas Malta Epilepsy Association led the delegation which presented the Prime Minister with an Epilepsy Toolkit, prepared entirely by the Association and funded by CPRD, the Commissioner for Rights of Persons with Disabilities and timed to be released in conjunction with International Epilepsy Day. Epilepsy, which is a hidden condition affects 1 in every 100 persons worldwide, thus making it a very common condition which can hit anyone at any age. It was very encouraging to see the needs of persons in Malta living with epilepsy being taken so seriously. Well done Caritas Malta Epilepsy Association for championing the cause and a huge appreciation to the Office of the Prime Minister for being so sensitive to the needs of the individuals and the families affected.
