THE COVID-19 SOLIDARITY BOXES BOLSTERING WELLBEING IN HOUSEHOLDS FACING FINANCIAL DIFFICULTIES

WHY?

The **COVID-19 SOLIDARITY BOXES** are being proposed as a form of emergency support for families in need during this challenging period. Their purpose is to provide a selection of basic goods to families who may have found themselves in serious financial difficulties unexpectedly, or whose financial insecurity has worsened due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The **COVID-19 SOLIDARITY BOXES** are a complimentary initiative to the research studies which Caritas Malta has been conducting since 2012 and which focused on a **Minimum Essential Budget for a Decent Living (MEBDL)**. The list of contents of the COVID-19 SOLIDARITY BOXES and the indication of their cost are being presented as a guide to those who are involved in providing emergency assistance to vulnerable families within the context of COVID-19 and to any potential donors who wish to support the various related initiatives. The ultimate goal is to help ensure a basic level of sustenance and wellbeing for all families, even during these difficult times.

WH0?

Four different boxes are being proposed targeting different household compositions: **2 adults and 2** children; **2 adults, 1 child and 1 infant; 1 adult and 2 children; and 2 elderly people.**

WHAT?

The contents of the four boxes are intended to offer support to families to be able to produce basic meals and snacks for around 14 days. They also provide a selection of household care, personal care and school and craft-related materials for children also to last for around 14 days, or even longer in some cases. Principles of sustainable living were given due consideration whilst developing the contents of the boxes.

All the boxes incorporate non-perishable food items, as well as fresh vegetables and fruit which have a moderate to long shelf life (e.g. potatoes, onions, apples). The food provided will need to be augmented by fresh and other staple items in order to provide full, healthy meals to sustain the families. The boxes also include a variety of consumable and non-consumable household and personal care products (e.g. detergents, soap, toothpaste, face masks, plasters, pain relief tablets vs. toothbrush, digital thermometer). Feminine hygiene and elderly dental care have also been addressed. Considering the myriad expenses incurred when there is an infant in the household, a special baby and nursery package has been created (e.g. baby food, powdered milk, nappies, sterilising liquid). A few stationery and hobby items have also been included for households with children to help in any school work, or to keep the young ones entertained whilst being creative. FOOD FOR HEALTH AND VERSATILITY

The food items in the boxes have been chosen to offer a variety of nutrients, whilst keeping in mind common dietary patterns, versatility and cost. Heavily processed foods have been kept to a minimum and fresh vegetables and fruits have been included as a rich source of energy-giving and protective nutrients. The combination of foods can be used to make pasta- or rice-based dishes, different soups, patties, salads, dips to accompany vegetables or galletti, spreads or fillings for breads, as well as simple snacks or desserts. By adding a selection of fresh and reasonably priced items, such as ricotta, yoghurt, eggs, chicken and seasonal vegetables and fruit, as well as some other staple ingredients, households can achieve a balanced set of meals for their family.



Beans and pulses are rich in protein, vitamin Bs, iron, potassium, phosphorus and magnesium and can acid

be used in salads, soups, stews, patties, dips and muffins.

Sardines are rich in protein, vitamin Bs and vitamin D, calcium and omega-3 fatty acids and can be used in pasta sauces, dips, or mashed as a spread or filling for pitta bread or toast.





Oats are a good source of fibre, phosphorus, magnesium and zinc and can be used for breakfast bowls, to thicken soups, or to make oat bars or raisin balls as sweet snacks.

Peanut butter is a good source of protein, vitamin Bs, vitamin E, potassium, magnesium and healthier fats and can be used as a spread, or in sauces, smoothies, or sweet dishes.

SUSTAINABLE CLEANING AND LAUNDERING

Apart from regular cleaning or laundry materials, vinegar and bicarbonate of soda have been included in order to make home-made, more natural or less costly cleaning and disinfecting agents. Diluted with water, mixed with each other or with some dish-washing liquid or lemon juice, different solutions can be made for different surfaces and uses.

BICARBONATE OF SODA	VINGEAR
-Odour neutraliser: Can be used to absorb odours from the air (e.g. inside fridge or shoe cupboard), to deodorise carpets and to eliminate perspiration odours and neutralise smell of chemicals in laundry. -Non-abrasive cleaner: Can be used sprinkled on a damp sponge or cloth to gently clean kitchen counter tops, ovens, sinks and bathtubs.	 -Scale remover: Can be used to help remove scale build-up from hard water. -Dirt remover: Can help dissolve greasy stains and tarnish from surfaces. -Softener: Can be added to laundry as an alternative softener. -Sanitiser: Can be used as a basic sanitiser (not effective against COVID-19): Pour 100ml white distilled vinegar into a spray bottle. Spray onto kitchen surfaces, refrigerator interior and taps. Leave for 10 minutes, then wipe with a clean paper towel.



HOW MUCH?

The different boxes vary in cost due to the choice of items which is based on the number of people in the household and their age. In some instances it was not logical or value for money to include a smaller sized item if there was only one adult in the household (e.g. packet cereal or lentils); in this case the item will last longer in that type of household. The box for households with an infant is the most costly due to various baby food and baby care expenses. One must point out that, despite its somewhat high price tag, a digital thermometer was deemed essential for all households; but it should last a few years if used well. Reusable face masks have also been included for each member of the household.
